## DRESS CODE



As a professional camping community, we recognize that campers gain a sense of security when they are given a clearly stated set of rules. Since we are a Christian ministry, our norms must be biblically based. For these reasons, and because we seek to promote outwardly what we believe inwardly, we would like to strongly encourage guardian cooperation with the following dress code. *Please address any questions to the Program Director*

At Countryside Camp & Conference Centre, modesty is required at all times.

- † Clothing with words, pictures, symbols or styling that unduly call attention to the body and/or are not in keeping with the expectations of a Christian community cannot be worn (this includes clothing with skulls and death images, slogans that may be interpreted as 'suggestive', etc).
- † Tops should have sleeves that cover the shoulders, although 'tank-tops' may be worn if the strap is as wide, or wider, than two adult finger widths.
- † The midriff must be covered during normal activity (including sports, sitting at campfire, meals, etc.)
- † Undergarments must not be visible at any time.
- † Shorts & skirts should be longer than the fingertips when arms are extended at the sides of the body
- † Skin-tight clothing is not permitted.
- † All females must wear a one piece bathing suit. Tankinis are acceptable as long as the midriff is fully covered.
- † Shirts and adequate footwear are required on ALL campers when not at the pool or on the waterslide
